

Master's Supervisory Committee

A supervisory committee for a Master of Arts or a Master of Science typically consists of three members of the graduate faculty including your advisor, designated as chair, and another member of the Department of Mathematics. Non-thesis Master of Science or Master of Arts committees may consist of the chair only. For each declared minor, a representative of the minor discipline is required to be on the committee. The graduate school requires that your supervisory committee be in place the term before you graduate.

Please consult with your advisor, mentor, or graduate coordinator about the composition of your committee. Print the names of your committee members on the lines below and ask them to indicate their willingness to serve by signing next to their name. Turn this form into the graduate secretary to inform her of the proposed composition of your committee, so that she can arrange to have the supervisory committee officially nominated by the department, approved by the dean of the college and appointed by graduate school.
